THE HARRY DENMAN EVANGELISM AWARD

Begun in 1981 to honor United Methodist clergy and lay persons in each annual conference who exhibit unusual and outstanding efforts for the work on Christian Evangelism, the Harry Denman Evangelism Award helps draw attention to evangelism in the local church. Those who are eligible for these prestigious awards are persons who are effective in helping others to experience the transforming love of God through Jesus Christ. Each year the North Georgia Annual Conference honors one youth, one lay person and one clergy person who has exhibited outstanding efforts in Wesleyan evangelism by

faithfully carrying out the mission of "making disciples of Jesus Christ.". Each district also recognizes these three persons in their districts as well.

The award is named for the late Dr. Harry Denman, who was a distinguished lay evangelist. The awards are made possible by The Foundation for Evangelism, which was founded in 1949 by Dr. Denman, who felt it was the business of every Christian to be an evangelist. It is most fitting that annual conferences today honor persons who carry on the spirit of Harry Denman.
