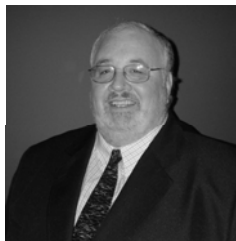
HOW?

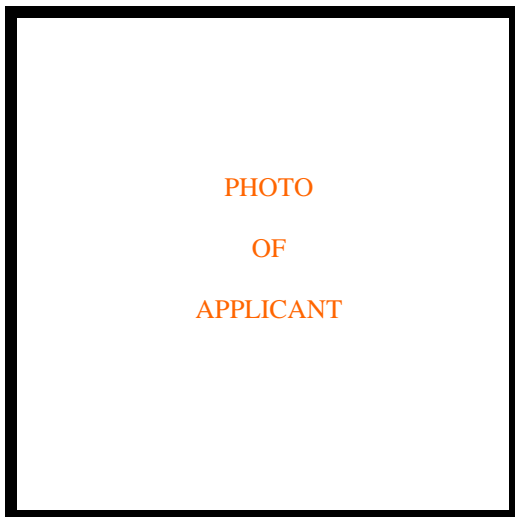
