General and Specific Responsibilities:

- Come to start of camp with lifeguard certification
- Participate in daily Crew meetings
- Life Guard
- Complete Level 1 Challenge Course training (belay certification)
- Assist at Challenge Course (belaying, leading team building with campers, etc.)
- Food Service/Dining Hall
- Clean camp
- Sanitize camp
- Facilitate parking
- Assist in camp store
- Mail sorting and delivery
- Aide Media Specialists
- Assist in event set-up and take-down
- Make pack-outs for camp-out
- Be present and active for Friday night Crew jobs (firewood, wash gators, clean pool, inventory program supplies, etc.)
- Assist with crafts coordinator
- Bar-b-que for All-Camp
- Be open and willing to participate in and lead worship in a variety of different ways throughout the summer (ie. reading scripture, guitar, sweep chapel, props, etc.)
