

THE COVENANT RELATIONSHIP PROGRAM

"The World is my parish," declared John Wesley. As heirs of that tradition, United Methodists have sent missionaries serving both inside and outside the U.S. Through missionary support, mission personnel have preached the Gospel, developed congregations and church leaders, offered education, community development and health care programs, and built numerous facilities including churches, schools, and hospitals.

SUPPORT UNITED METHODIST MISSIONARIES BY:

Entering into a Covenant Relationship with one or more General Board of Global Ministries' (GBGM) missionaries. *(A Covenant Relationship allows your congregation to become personally acquainted with missionaries and their work.)*

It can help inspire your church members to become more committed to God's mission in our world through the missionary outreach of The United Methodist Church.

As you consider the needs and resources of your local congregations, prayerfully consider entering into a covenant relationship with a missionary.

Be in Covenant with the entire missionary community and in Relationship with a particular missionary.

CHURCH RESPONSIBILITIES:

Select a missionary to support.

As a congregation, you can support a missionary for at least **\$2,500 or \$5 per member per year.**

Pray for and write to your missionary.

MISSIONARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

Communicate by letter at least three times per year.

During scheduled periods of itineration, visit covenant congregation.

At the scheduled time of itineration, the missionary will work with the Conference Board of Global Ministries in arranging itineration within the Conference.

Pray for covenant congregation.

BEING A GLOBAL MISSION PARTNER CONGREGATION

- Pay 100% of your World Service and conference asking.
- Be intentional about mission education in your congregation.
- Be involved in local community outreach ministries.
- Support a missionary commissioned by the GBGM in a Covenant Relationship.
- Support a Person-in-Mission (PIMs - persons from countries outside the U.S. serving in their own country or another country, not commissioned by GBGM).
- Share your experience with two neighboring congregations.

ADDITIONALLY

For just \$2.00 per member or \$1,000 for congregations with membership over 500, you can be in relationship with a Person-in-Mission.
