

## Prayers for Developing a Servant's Heart

The image of Jesus humbly washing His disciple's feet during the last Passover Feast is a powerful one. His willingness to perform this menial task demonstrates the full extent of His love and also teaches by example that the Christ did not come to be served, but to serve (Matt. 20:28).

If your Christian walk involves surrender, sacrifice, and a mindset that puts other people first and your own self-interests last, you will be blessed according to Jesus' promise recorded in John 13:14-17. Here are 10 tips for developing a servant's heart.

1. Love the Lord your God with all your heart, soul, mind, and strength.
2. Love your neighbor as yourself.
3. In humility, regard other people as precious in the sight of God.
4. Ask God to give you the servant mindset of Jesus.
5. Pray God equips you and the Body of Christ for service.
6. Serve out of your love for Jesus.
7. Search for ways to serve in your church and community.
8. Perform secret acts of kindness.
9. In the spirit of Christ, put others first.
10. Study Scripture passages on servitude including Phil. 2:1-11; Luke 22:24-27; John 13:1-17; Matt. 20:27-28; Eph. 5:21; Rom. 6:20-23; 1 Pet. 2:16, and Gal. 5:13.
